




Marunouchi and Nihonbashi Area


Shibuya and Aoyama Area


Ikebukuro Area

Walkable City Tour around 4 parks



Tour overview

Toshima Ward in Tokyo stands out as the most densely populated area in Japan. Interestingly, in 2014, it was singled out as the only ward among Tokyo's 23 wards that could potentially vanish. This designation spurred the ward to adopt the theme of "'People' as Key Contributors in Urban Progress." This approach involves a collaboration between the public and private sectors to leverage public spaces. With the Toshima Ward Office's relocation in 2015, the city actively advanced walkable urban expansion, particularly around four parks near Ikebukuro Station. This tour offers participants a firsthand experience of how public spaces can be harnessed to enhance local property values.

Tour overview

We will lead you through the urban evolution of two very different suburban areas. Tachikawa, in the center of West Tokyo, initially revolved around industrial and commercial activities linked to a military airfield. Over time, it has morphed into a wellness-oriented locale by utilizing the space to establish a sprawling park and verdant commercial facilities. On the other hand, Kohoku New Town, developed as the city's populace expanded, has matured using the Green Matrix System which balances the preservation of natural resources with residential development, and has become a model for environmentally friendly urban development. In the second part of the tour, visitors will explore the night ambiance of Yokohama, a premier tourist destination in Japan.


