

Setagaya-ward is known as residential city, located at south-west of Tokyo 23 wards where 940,000 people reside. Natural Infrastructure with Green and Water such as Tama River, Kokubunji Cliff Line, Kitazawa River, Karasuyama River, Jyakuzure River and Open Spaces in various scale exist throughout the city. Three Railway Infrastructure such as Keio Line, Odakyu Line, and Tokyu Line extend from East to West, and small cities stand in a row along railways. Road structures consist of two
